


Maryland Public High School Graduates - Initial Postsecondary Enrollments

Details: The data below provide the number and percentages of Maryland public high school graduates who have an initial enrollment in a college or university any year after graduating. Next, the number and percentage of those enrollees attending a Maryland college or university versus an out-of-state college or university are provided.

Important note : The number of college or university enrollments in 2014 is lower than prior years because there is only one year of enrollments after graduation. All other years include at least two or more years of enrollments after high school.

Suggestions for Use: These data are responsive to Research Agenda Question # 2, “What percentage of Maryland high school exiters go on to enroll in Maryland postsecondary education.”

Highlights: These data show a trend of in-state initial enrollments among Maryland high school graduates. Specifically, a consistent majority (72%) of Maryland high school graduates who initially enroll in a college or university do so at a Maryland college or university.

Notes: Future dashboards will examine outcomes of students who did not graduate high school and will broaden the definition of postsecondary outcomes to include private career schools and continuing education and training certificate sequences.

Data Limitations and Caveats :

- ★ Graduates who enrolled in Private Career Schools or Continuing Education and Training Certificate sequences are not included in this report.
 - ★ This dashboard uses “initial enrollment,” which counts only the first enrollment of a student after graduation. For example, a student graduates high school, enrolls in a summer community college course, and then enrolls in an out-of-state college in the fall. The initial enrollment count for that student is one in-state enrollment. Other methods of counting enrollment may count that student as one in-state and one out-of-state enrollment. Accordingly, when reviewing, and especially when comparing post-secondary enrollment reports, it is important to understand how the enrollments are being counted.
 - ★ The number of high school graduates reported on this dashboard includes: (a) only the counts of 12th grade graduates; and (b) eliminates any duplicate graduation records.
