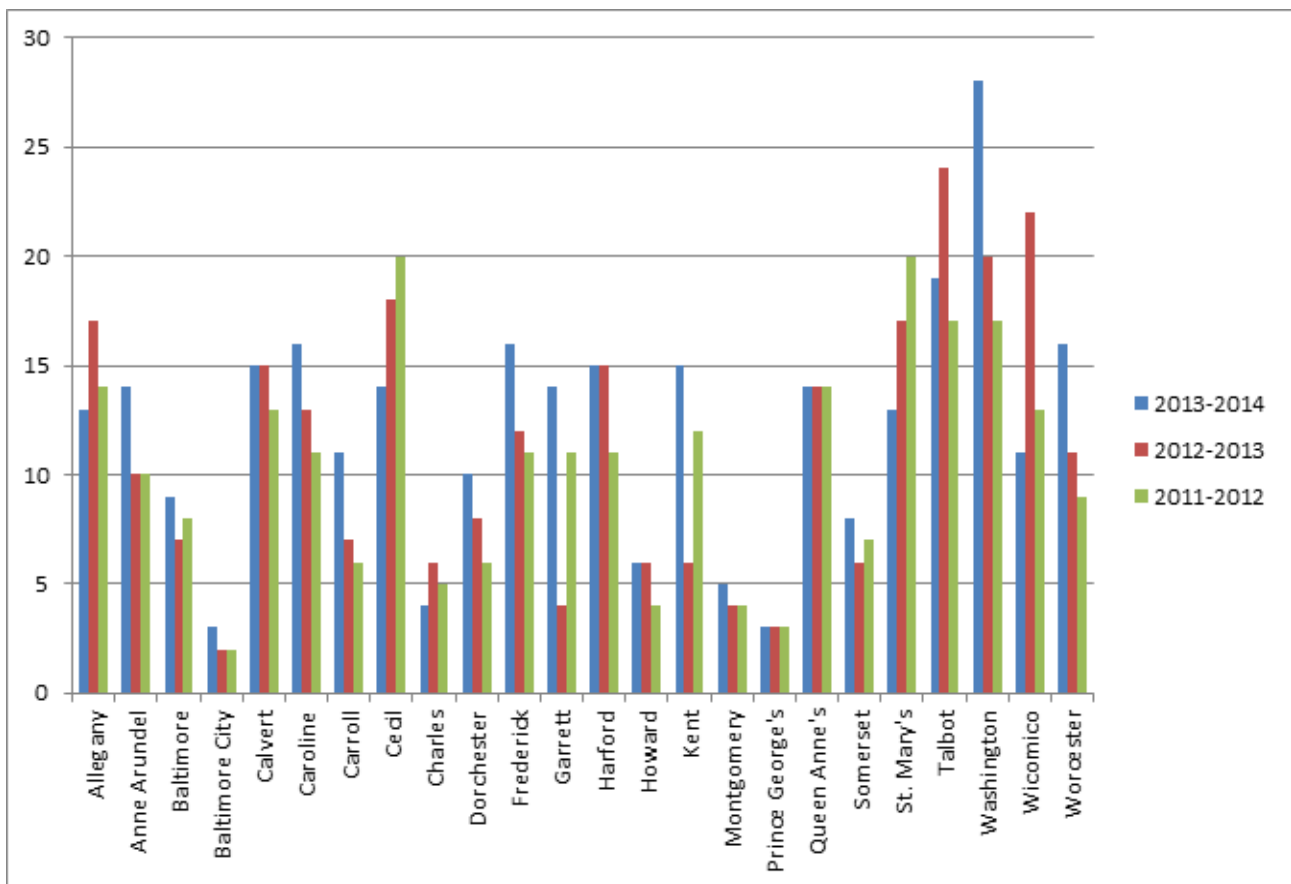


Dual Enrollment by County
